Packaging Requirements for Protection of Electromechanical and Electro-optical Devices

Packaging of Electromechanical and Electro-optical Devices shall conform to the following requirements:

- Packaging, packing, and preservation shall be in accordance with Best Commercial Practices (MIL-STD-2073-1E may be used as a guide for materials and processes.)
- Protection shall be provided to prevent physical damage and to maintain position of leads or terminal during handling and transportation. Material used for this protection shall be noncorrosive. Items may be taped to a cardboard or fiber backer.
- Single unit packing shall be used. (QUP=1) Individual items shall be packed in a bag and sealed (i.e., taped shut) to prevent contamination.
- Adequate packing dunnage shall be used to prevent items from contacting one another during shipment.
- Both internal and external packaging containers shall be marked with a "Caution Fragile" label or an appropriate equivalent.

NOTE: Failure to comply with these packaging requirements will result in rejection of the entire lot of devices at Receiving Inspection.
